

On or about May 31, 2020, at the corner of Pennsylvania and Washington Streets in Indianapolis, Indiana, NATHANIEL SCHAUWECKER did knowingly touch Ivore Westfield in a rude, insolent, or angry manner, by hitting Ivore Westfield with a deadly weapon, that is: a baton;

COUNT II

On or about May 31, 2020, at the corner of Pennsylvania and Washington Streets in Indianapolis, Indiana, NATHANIEL SCHAUWECKER did knowingly touch Ivore Westfield in a rude, insolent, or angry manner, by hitting Ivore Westfield with a baton, which resulted in moderate bodily injury to Ivore Westfield, that is: substantial pain;

COUNT III

On or about May 31, 2020, at the corner of Pennsylvania and Washington Streets in Indianapolis, Indiana, NATHANIEL SCHAUWECKER did knowingly touch Ivore Westfield in a rude, insolent, or angry manner, by hitting Ivore Westfield with a baton, which resulted in bodily injury to Ivore Westfield, that is: pain;

COUNT IV

On or about May 31, 2020, at the corner of Pennsylvania and Washington Streets in Indianapolis, Indiana, NATHANIEL SCHAUWECKER did knowingly touch Rachel Harding in a rude, insolent, or angry manner, by hitting Rachel Harding with a baton, which resulted in bodily injury to Rachel Harding, that is: pain;


