CASE NO. 003-738-02-13

1. Said individual is Multi Certified (Basic Law Enforcement officer, Radar Operator).
2. Said officer was employed with the most recent law enforcement unit on 01/03/11.
3. Said officer is not currently employed with a law enforcement unit.
4. The officer responded to this investigation. (See Attachment A)

CASE SUMMARY

On or about 10/02/12, the officer was terminated after an internal affairs investigation revealed the officer had opened three lines of credit using another officer's identifying information without permission. The officer used the lines of credit to make purchases totaling \$ 11,498.70. The agency turned their findings over to the District Attorney's office for review and prosecution.

On or about 03/25/14, An Accusation was entered on the officer for 7 counts of Financial Identity Fraud (Fe), 4 counts of Computer Forgery (Fe), and 2 counts of Financial Transaction Card Fraud (Fe).

On or about 07/01/14, the officer pled guilty to 1 count of Financial Identity Fraud (Fe). He received 10 years probation under the First Offenders Act which may be terminated after 5 years if full restitution is made. The officer was also ordered to pay \$11,498.70 in restitution and to not have contact with the victim of the crime.

It is hereby asserted this individual is in violation of the following sections of O.C.G.A. 35-8-7.1 (6);(7);(8)(a), as attached:

Sir,

I have received notice that POST is investigating my termination from Savannah Metropolitan PD.

On August 23rd 2012 a former roommate accused me of opening a credit card account in his name and using it. This is indeed not factual. we had a verbal agreement and I was placed on the accounts also. The bank had my pertinent information such as my SSN, DOB etc. All bills were paid and are still being paid. The creditors in question agree there was never any fraud detected, and do not believe any fraud took place.

To this date I still make payments and have sole responsibility for the debt. The accuser has been released of any liability.

I was terminated for conduct unbecoming an officer based on his unproven allegations.

To this date, over 7 months later I have not been charged with any crime nor arrested for any matter.

I am 38 years old and have never had any legal issue, up until a month ago I had not even received a traffic citation. I recently received a stop sign violation which is being challenged.

I would like POST to consider that there has been no proof of the allegations and it is a he said she said matter.

SCMPD terminated me with no proof of the allegation, only the accusers word. The accuser got angry when I missed a payment and was afraid it was going to damage his credit. The creditor has removed him of liability and once again I am the sole responsible party.

I urge GA POST to keep my status active and clear my POST record so that I may someday do what I love to do, serve the community as a Police Officer.
