COUNT 1: PETIT LARCENY ~ 21 O.S. § 1704, a MISDEMEANOR
COUNT 2: IMPERSONATING A POLICE OFFICER~21 O.S. § 264, a MISDEMEANOR

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF CHOCTAW:

I, **Jeffrey C. Smith**, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority, and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Choctaw and in the State of Oklahoma, **ALLEN LEE GOLDEN**, did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT 1: PETIT LARCENY ~ a MISDEMEANOR, on or about the 25th day of September, 2015, by taking and carrying away by stealth \$2.00 cash, that belonged to Vickie Lynn Cox, without the consent of Vickie Lynn Cox, and with the intent to deprive Vickie Lynn Cox of the taken money permanently.

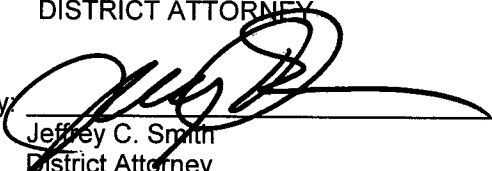
This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 6 months or a fine of \$10-\$500, or both.

COUNT 2: 21 O.S. § 264 ~ IMPERSONATING A POLICE OFFICER, a MISDEMEANOR, on or about the 25th day of September, 2015, by holding himself out, without due authority, to Vickie Lynn Cox, as a law enforcement officer with Boswell Police Department.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 1 year and a fine of up to \$100.
