- COUNT 3: OBSTRUCTING A POLICE OFFICER ~ 21 O.S. § 540, a MISDEMEANOR
- COUNT 4: RESISTING ARREST ~ 21 O.S. § 268, a MISDEMEANOR

STATE OF OKLAHOMA, COUNTY OF LOGAN:

I, Laura Austin Thomas, the undersigned District Attorney of said County, in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, give information that in said County of Logan and in the State of Oklahoma, **NANCY ELIZABETH KEMP** did then and there unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT 1: IMPROPER USE OF MULTIPLE-BEAM ROD-LIGHTING EQUIPMENT ~ a MISDEMEANOR, That is to say, the said defendant, Nancy Kemp, on the **11th day of May, 2022** at approximately the 0029 hour of the morning and in the County and State aforesaid, then and there being did unlawfully, willfully, and knowingly drive and operate a certain motor vehicle, to wit: a 2008 black Chrysler Sebring with Oklahoma tag number 7734 UD002 in Logan County, Oklahoma to wit: the defendant was NB on I 35 new Seward Road exit near the city of Guthrie and was driving with her bright lights on while following a vehicle within six hundred (600) feet to the rear of said vehicle thereby shining overly bright lights into the eyes of the driver of said vehicle.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 10 days and a fine of \$5 up to \$500.

COUNT 2: OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL ~ a MISDEMEANOR, That is to say, the said defendant, Nancy Kemp, on the 11th day of May, 2022 at approximately the 0029 hour of the morning and in the County and State aforesaid, then and there being did unlawfully, willfully and knowingly drive and operate a certain motor vehicle, to wit: a 2008 black Chrysler Sebring with Oklahoma tag number 7734 UD002 in Logan County, Oklahoma to with: the defendant was NB on I 35 new the Seward Road exit near the City of Guthrie while the said defendant, Nancy Elizabeth Kemp, was under the influence of alcohol with a flood alcohol concentration of .08 g/100 mL or more specifically at the time of blood draw was .093, in violation of 47 O.S. § 11-902(A)(1), contrary to the from and the statute in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment of not less than Ten (10) days in jail and/or a fine of up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00), or by both fine and imprisonment.

OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE

COUNT 2: OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF A COMBINATION OF ALCOHOL AND AN INTOXICATING SUBSTANCE ~ a MISDEMEANOR, That is to say, the said Nancy Elizabeth Kemp, on the 11th day of May, 2022, and in Logan County and State of Oklahoma, then and there being did unlawfully, willfully, and knowingly drive and operate a certain motor vehicle, to wit: Year of 2008, black Chrysler Sebring, license number license Plate Number 7734 UD002, in Logan County, Oklahoma to wit: NB on Interstate 35 by the Seward Road Exit near City of Guthrie while the said Nancy Elizabeth Kemp was under the influence of alcohol and of other intoxicating substance, to-wit: two (2) strains of THC in violation of 47 O.S. § 11-902(A)(5), contrary to the form and the statute in such cases made and provided and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment of not less than Ten (10) days in jail and/or a fine of up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1000), or by both fine and imprisonment.

COUNT 3: OBSTRUCTING A POLICE OFFICER ~ a MISDEMEANOR, On or about the 11th day of May, 2022 in Logan County, State of Oklahoma, Nancy Elizabeth Kemp did commit the crime of OBSTRUCTING A POLICE OFFICER, a misdemeanor in violation of 21 O.S. § 540, by willfully obstructing one Highway Patrol Trooper Preston Cox, who defendant knew to be a Police Officer in the performance of his official duties; to wit, said Nancy Kemp, did refuse lawful commands to stop using her phone during the stop and investigation, and did grab for her driver license from the computer of Trooper Cox which was on the side of his gun leg and did flee from the traffic stop.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment up to 1 year and/or up to \$500, or both.

COUNT 4: RESISTING ARREST ~ a MISDEMEANOR, On or about the 11th day of May, 2022, in Logan County, state of Oklahoma, Nancy Elizabeth Kemp unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and intentionally committed the crime of RESISTING ARREST, a misdemeanor, by ignoring commands from Oklahoma Highway Patrol Trooper Preston Cox and failing to comply with his orders to stop, to give him her hands, but instead Nancy Elizabeth Kemp did open the passenger door, while grabbing her license, and tried to remove herself from detention and then fought with Trooper while he was trying to restrain her to prevent further injury to himself and her, and while the Trooper was trying to keep an intoxicated person from getting back in their own car or running onto an interstate, further Nancy Elizabeth Kemp did refuse to remove her hands from under her body and when forced to comply did pull her hand from the handcuffs resulting in another altercation wherein Nancy Kemp tried to reach for objects under and/or near her body as the Trooper tried to gain compliance, in violation of sections 268 of title 21 of the Oklahoma statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 1 year, or a fine of up to \$500, or both.

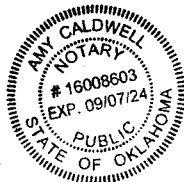
