Dear Counsel,

Pursuant to *Brady v. Maryland*, 373 US 83 (1963) and *Giglio v. United States*, 405 US 150 (1972), I am disclosing the following information:

On March 24, 2021, Detective Trooper Nicholas Cianci (Vermont State Police) was arraigned on a charge of misdemeanor domestic assault by the Grand Isle County State's Attorney's office as a deputy of the Orange County State's Attorney.

The Information and Affidavit filed are attached hereto.

Although there is no evidence to suggest that Trooper Cianci's reports filed in any of our pending cases are not accurate, this information is disclosed consistent with the State's Constitutional and ethical requirements, including V.R.Cr.P 16(a)(2)(G) and (b)(2) to ensure

awareness of this matter for purposes of discovery planning and disposition of pending cases where Trooper Cianci was the investigating officer.
