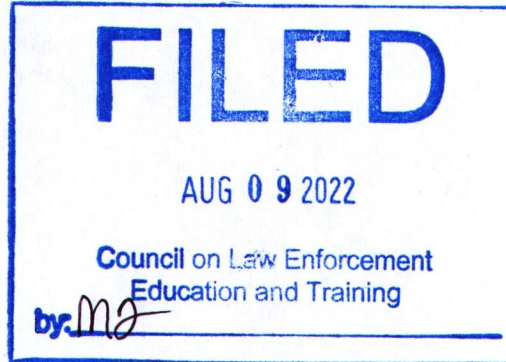

FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET hereinafter), pursuant to 70 O.S. § 3311 and OAC Title 390 Chapter 2, does hereby enter this Final Order of Revocation in the above cause:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That Respondent is a certified Peace Officer, Reserve Officer, and Basic Instructor in the State of Oklahoma.
2. That on or about April 29, 2022, Respondent was named the Defendant in a Final Order of Protection in the District Court of Choctaw Nation case PO-22-40.
3. That pursuant to 70 O.S. § 3311, “The Council shall revoke the certification of any person upon determining that such person has been convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude or a domestic violence offense or has entered a plea of guilty, or nolo contendere or an "Alford" plea or any plea other than a not guilty plea for a felony offense, a crime of moral turpitude or a crime of domestic violence or is the respondent in a final Victims Protective Order. . .”
4. That pursuant to 70 OS 3311, “The Council shall revoke the certification of any person upon determining that such person has been convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude or a domestic violence offense or has entered a plea of guilty, or nolo contendere or an "Alford" plea or any plea other than a not guilty plea for a felony offense, a crime of moral turpitude or a crime of domestic violence or is the respondent in a final Victims Protective Order. . .”
5. That pursuant to 70 OS 3311, “The Council shall revoke the certification of any person upon determining that such person has received a deferred sentence for a felony, a crime involving moral turpitude or a domestic violence offense.”
6. That Notice of Intent to Revoke was mailed via certified, return-receipt requested, tracking number 7020 0640 0001 4675 8747, on July 6, 2022, to Respondent at his or her address on file with CLEET.

7. That on or about July 14, 2022, CLEET received the mailing back corresponding with certified mail tracking number 7020 0640 0001 4675 8747 "RETURN TO SENDER UNCLAIMED UNABLE TO FORWARD".
8. That pursuant to 70 OS § 3311(P), "Peace officers, reserve peace officers, tribal peace officers, agencies, bail enforcers, security guards and private investigators shall maintain with the Council current mailing addresses and shall notify the Council, in writing, of any change of address or name. Notification of change of name shall require certified copies of any marriage license or other court document which reflects the change of name. Notice of change of address or telephone number must be made within ten (10) days of the effected change. Notices shall not be accepted over the phone. In any proceeding in which the Council is required to serve notice or an order on an individual or an agency, the Council may send a letter to the mailing address on file with the Council. If the letter is returned and a notation of the U.S. Postal Service indicates "unclaimed", or "moved", or "refused" or any other nondelivery markings and the records of the Council indicate that no change of address as required by this subsection has been received by the Council, the notice and any subsequent notices or orders shall be deemed by the Court as having been legally served for all purposes"
9. That no request for hearing has been received pursuant to OAC Title 390 Chapter 2.
10. That Notice is deemed properly served.


DISPOSITION

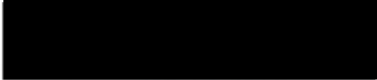
NOTIFICATION OF APPEAL RIGHTS

You are hereby notified that any determination in an individual proceeding shall be subject to rehearing, reopening or reconsideration by the agency within ten (10) days of its entry, 75 O.S. § 317. If an application for rehearing is not filed, you are entitled to judicial review by filing a petition for review in the District Court within thirty (30) days after you are notified of this determination, 75 O.S. §318. Copies of such petition shall be served upon this agency within ten (10) days after filing such petition.
