## **AMENDED INFORMATION**

FOR:

COUNT 1: DIST OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE - INCL POSS W/INTENT - C.N.C.C. § 2-401B1-3, a FELONY

COUNT 2: UNLAWFUL REMOVAL OF A DEAD BODY - C.N.C.C. § 1161(A), a FELONY

COUNT 3POSS OF CDS - MARIJUANA - C.N.C.C. § 2-402A, a MISDEMEANOR

COUNT 4: POSSESSION OF FIREARM WHILE COMMITING FELONY - C.N.C.C. § 1287, a FELONY CHOCTAW NATION OF OKLAHOMA:

I, Kara Bacon, the undersigned Tribal Prosecutor, in the name and by the authority of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, give information that within this Tribal Court, **BRYAN E DENNY**, the Defendant, herein, who is an adult Indian male, did then there unlawfully, knowingly, and wrongfully commit the crime(s) of:

COUNT 1: DIST OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE - INCL POSS W/INTENT ~ a FELONY, on or about the 31st day of August 2022, by knowingly and intentionally possessing Cocaine, a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, with the intent to distribute the same.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for 2-3 years and a fine of up to \$5,000.00.

COUNT 2: UNLAWFUL REMOVAL OF A DEAD BODY ~ a FELONY, on or about the 31st day of August 2022, by intentionally removing a jawbone from a dead human being from the initial site where such dead body is located.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 3 years and/or a fine of up to \$5,000.00.

COUNT 3: POSS OF CDS - MARIJUANA ~ a MISDEMEANOR, on or about the 31st day of August 2022, by knowingly and intentionally having in Defendant's possession under the Defendant's control Marijuana, said drug being classified as a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma.

This crime is punishable by imprisonment for up to 1 year and fine of up to \$1,000.00.

COUNT 4: POSSESSION OF FIREARM WHILE COMMITING FELONY ~ a FELONYY, on or about the 31st day of August 2022, by willfully and unlawfully possessing a .22 caliber Henry semi-automatic rifle, a 12-gauge Remington pump-action shotgun, and a .50 caliber Thompson Center Muzzleloader, while committing the felony charge of Possession of CDS with Intent to Distribute.

This crime is punishable for not less than two years nor more than three years.
