### **TISHOMINGO, Okla. —**

Three law enforcement officers have been placed on administrative leave after they were involved in the deadly shooting of a man who they said rammed his vehicle into a patrol car, according to Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation officials.

On Tuesday, Tishomingo officers and Johnston County deputies responded to report of family violence in the 1400 block of North Elks Road, where OSBI agents said a man rammed his vehicle into a Tishomingo Police Department patrol car. The man continued pushing the patrol car backward until two Tishomingo officers and one Johnston County deputy opened fire, hitting the man, officials said.

The man was then taken to Tishomingo Mercy Hospital, where he was pronounced dead. His identity has not been released.

The deputy was not hurt, but the two Tishomingo officers suffered minor injuries, according to officials.

The officers have been placed on administrative leave, officials said. Their names will not be released unless criminal charges are filed.

OSBI agents have been asked to investigate the shooting. Once their investigation is complete, a report will be sent to the Johnston County district attorney, who will determine if the shooting was justified.
