AGREED FINAL ORDER OF SUSPENSION

The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET hereinafter) and, pursuant to 70 OS § 3311 et al and Rule 390:10-1-7, does hereby enter this Final Order on the above cause:

**FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. That Respondent is a certified Reserve Peace Officer and Peace Officer in the State of Oklahoma.
2. That on or about January 06, 2021, a Final Order of Suspension was entered against Respondent in case 104600-20 due to failure to meet the statutory continuing education requirements for the calendar year 2019.
3. That at the time of the suspension, Respondent was not commissioned.
4. That a copy of the Final Order of Suspension was mailed to Respondent at his address of record.
5. That on or about April 06, 2022, Respondent became commissioned by Blaine County Sheriff's Office.
6. That on or about June 17, 2022, a Final Order of Reinstatement was filed in case 104600-20.
7. That on or about May 26, 2022, CLEET received a statement from Respondent advising that he had actively worked as a Peace Officer during which time his certification was suspended as he was unaware of his suspension.
8. That pursuant to 70 OS § 3311.4 and Rule 390:10-1-7(b)(1) his CLEET certification should be suspended for a minimum of two (2) weeks.
9. That working while suspended is a violation of statute and rules.
10. That CLEET has the authority to promulgate the rules and take disciplinary actions involving individuals with peace officer certifications pursuant to 70 OS § 3311.

**DISPOSITION**

1. That prior to any hearing the parties have agreed to the following settlement of all issues:

- a. Respondent is suspended for a period of two weeks to be served on the following dates: September 17, 2022-October 1, 2022.
- b. During said suspension, Respondent shall not work as nor hold himself out as a certified peace officer.
- c. Within 5 business days after October 1, 2022, Respondent and Travis Daughtery Blaine County Sheriff, must submit a written statement under penalty of perjury to CLEET verifying that Respondent has complied with the agreed terms of this suspension.
- d. Following the period of suspension, Respondent's certification will automatically be reinstated.
- e. Should Respondent fail to comply with any of the terms of this agreement, his peace officer certification shall be summarily suspended for a period of 180 days from the date CLEET becomes aware of the violation.




