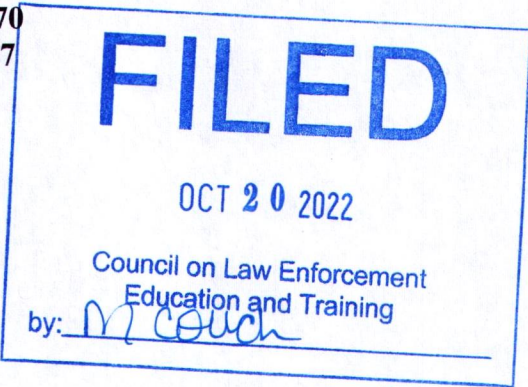

FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET hereinafter), pursuant to 70 O.S. § 3311 and OAC Title 390 Chapter 2, does hereby enter this Final Order of Revocation in the above cause:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That Respondent is a certified Peace Officer in the State of Oklahoma.
2. That on or about November 21, 2021, Respondent was charged with Driving a Motor Vehicle While Under the Influence of Alcohol in the Municipal District Court of the City of Oklahoma City, Citation No.186685672.
3. That on or about May 3, 2022, Respondent entered a plea of nolo contendere to Driving a Motor Vehicle While Under the Influence of Alcohol in violation of 47 O.S. § 11-902(A)(2) and Oklahoma City Municipal Code Chapter 32 Article 7(a) and received a continued sentence.
4. That driving a motor vehicle while under the influence is a crime of moral turpitude.
5. That pursuant to 70 OS § 3311, “The Council shall revoke the certification of any person upon determining that such person has been convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude or a domestic violence offense or has entered a plea of guilty, or nolo contendere or an "Alford" plea or any plea other than a not guilty plea for a felony offense, a crime of moral turpitude or a crime of domestic violence or is the respondent in a final Victims Protective Order. . . .”
6. That pursuant to 70 OS § 3311, “The Council shall revoke the certification of any person upon determining that such person has received a deferred sentence for a felony, a crime involving moral turpitude or a domestic violence offense.”
7. That on or about July 26, 2022, Notice of Intent to Revoke was mailed via certified, return-receipt requested, restricted delivery, tracking number 7020 0640 0001 4675 8860 to Respondent’s address on file with CLEET and 7020 0640 0001 4675 8853 to an address listed on Respondent’s court records.

8. That on or about August 08, 2022, CLEET received the mailing back corresponding with certified mail tracking number 7020 0640 0001 4675 8860 "RETURN TO SENDER ATTEMPTED-NOT KNOWN UNABLE TO FORWARD".
9. That on or about August 12, 2022, CLEET received the mailing back corresponding with certified mail tracking number 7020 0640 0001 4675 8853 "RETURN TO SENDER UNABLE TO FORWARD".
10. That as of the date of this Final Order of Revocation, there has been no change of address.
11. That pursuant to 70 O.S. § 3311(P), individuals regulated by CLEET are obligated to maintain a current mailing address on file with CLEET and notices properly delivered to such address constitute good service.
12. That no request for hearing has been received pursuant to OAC Title 390 Chapter 2.


DISPOSITION



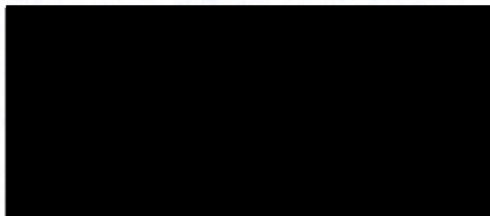
