NARRATIVE No: 1 - Officer: ANDERSON, BRYLUN

On April 26, 2022, at approximately 1319, I Deputy Anderson was dispatched to the Valero at exit 40 for a white male with a cream-colored shirt, jeans, and a cream-colored hat that was arguing with another male subject inside the store and pulled a knife. The reporting party advised that both male subjects were outside the store now.

When I arrived on the scene, I observed the male subject speaking to a female, later identified as Debra Rose, and I got out of my unit. When the male subject, later identified as Billy Bailey, saw me, he pulled a knife out of his pocket, opened it up, and started yelling and cursing at me and walking toward me. He advised me that he would cut me and that he was a veteran. I advised onlookers to get back because he was coming at me with a knife, and I advised dispatch that he was coming at me with a knife and to notify the Sheriff and Undersheriff. I got into my and backed it up about 15-20 yards to create separation between us. I got out of my car and commanded him to drop the knife, but he refused. Billy went to the first diesel pump and pulled the nozzle out, which still had diesel fluid in the hose, and it went onto the ground. Billy reached in his pocket, pulled out a lighter, and tried to ignite the diesel but was unable to. I advised dispatch to get the fire department on standby in case he was able to get it to ignite. Billy began to get frustrated because the diesel did not ignite and came towards me again.

I gave Billy verbal commands to put the knife down and advised him that I would use less lethal force with a bean bag round if he did not. Billy still would not comply with my commands. I got on the radio and told dispatch to contact the Sheriff to authorize me to use a less-lethal bean bag. The Sheriff then got on the radio and authorized less-lethal force. I went to the trunk of my unit and loaded up my 40mm less lethal with one bean bag round, and approached Billy giving him verbal commands. When Billy realized that I had my less-lethal weapon in my hand, he advised me not to shoot him and threw the knife and lighter on the ground. I gave Billy verbal commands to get on the ground and lay face down; Billy would not comply and started rolling back and forth under the semi-trailer and the second pump. Another Deputy arrived on the scene, and we were able to get Billy to lay face down and we were able to get Billy into wrist restraints without incident.

I placed Billy in the back of my unit and had medics come check him out to be medically cleared. The medics transported Billy to the emergency room for further evaluation and released him to my custody at approximately 1717.

NARRATIVE No: 2 - Officer: ANDERSON, BRYLUN

On April 27, 2022, at approximately 1129, I Deputy Anderson went to the Valero to obtain video of the incident inside the store and to get a statement from the clerk Ali Zaib that was working during the incident.

I went outside to the first Diesel pump and took photos of the damage to the hose that Billy attempted to cut. I walked over to the second pump labeled #9 and took pictures of the cuts in that hose.

I went back inside and downloaded surveillance video from inside the store. I asked the clerk where the outside video was, and he advised me that the camera did not catch the incident outside of the store due to one of the semis blocking the view and the camera's angle.

I also obtained a video from a witness on the scene, which will be attached to this report. His identity is unknown due to him leaving the scene. The two other witnesses that you could see in the video were Ben Miller and Ernesto Perez. Their statements were attached to the report. The Deputy that came to assist me in getting Billy in custody was Deputy Cathey. Their statements were attached to the report.

At the time of this report, I am trying to locate the individual inside the store that Billy attacked. Debra Rose stated that the individual's name was Josh Lindsey.
