

ORDER DETERMINING VENUE, REQUIRING TRANSMITTAL OF INDICTMENT TO COUNTY OF VENUE, AND AUTHORIZING DISTRICT COURT TO OPEN FOR PURPOSE OF ISSUANCE OF WARRANT

NOW on this 14 day of April, 2022, the Court having been present, in open court, an indictment returned by the Oklahoma Multicounty Grand Jury, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. Said indictment having been examined by the Court, the Court pursuant to the provisions of 22 O.S. Section 358, finds and orders that venue and jurisdiction shall be in Custer County, State of Oklahoma.
2. That said indictment shall be transmitted by the Attorney General, or one of his Assistant Attorneys General, to the District Court Clerk of Custer County, who, thereafter, upon receipt shall notify the District Judge of Custer County of the filing of the same;
3. That the District Judge of Custer County shall proceed according to the provisions of Title 22 O.S. Section 386.
