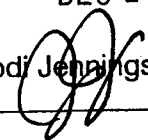

ORDER DEFERRING IMPOSITION OF JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE

Now on this 9TH day of DECEMBER, 2021, the same being a judicial day of said Court, and the defendant, being personally present in open Court with Attorney Jason May, and having been legally charged with the crime(s) of COUNT I: TAKING CLANDESTINE PHOTOGRAPHS, A FELONY, 21 O.S. § 1171 (B) and COUNT II: TAKING CLANDESTINE PHOTOGRAPHS, A FELONY, 21 O.S. § 1171 (B) and being informed of the nature of the charges, and of the Constitutional rights of the accused, and the effect and nature of the charges, and duly arraigned thereon, and having voluntarily waived those rights, and having duly and properly entered a plea of GUILTY to the crime(s) of COUNT I: TAKING CLANDESTINE PHOTOGRAPHS, A FELONY, 21 O.S. § 1171 (B) and COUNT II: TAKING CLANDESTINE PHOTOGRAPHS, A FELONY, 21 O.S. § 1171 (B); and the Court having inquired whether there is any legal cause to show why judgment and sentence should not be pronounced against the defendant, and defendant stating no sufficient cause why Judgment and Sentence should not be pronounced, and none appearing to the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE the decision and order of the Court to defer the imposition of sentence in this case for a period of FIVE (5) YEARS in COUNT I and COUNT II, with said sentences to run concurrent.

IT IS FURTHER the decision and order of the Court that the defendant is hereby placed on SUPERVISED PROBATION and shall be supervised by the Murray County District Attorney's Office for a period of EIGHTEEN (18) MONTHS. Said defendant shall abide the rules and conditions as ordered by the Court, to specifically include no law violations of any City, State, Federal, or Tribal laws. Said defendant shall obtain a mental health evaluation, with proof provided, and follow the recommendations of said evaluation. Said defendant shall have no unconsented contact with the victim of said case. Said defendant shall report by the 10th day of each month, beginning January, 2022, and pay the statutory supervision fee of \$40.00 per month.

IT IS FURTHER the decision and order of the Court that said defendant shall pay a judicial assessment of \$1,000.00 in COUNT I and \$1,000.00 in COUNT II, which shall be paid at the rate as computed by the Fee Cost Administrator.

IT IS FURTHER the decision and order of the Court that the defendant pay all related court cost and assessments in COUNT I and COUNT II, as per the schedule, which shall be paid at the rate as computed by the Fee Cost Administrator.

Defendant is advised of the right and procedure to appeal.
