OSAGE COUNTY, OKLA. (KTUL) — An Osage County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) deputy was arrested for bringing contraband into the county jail.

Deputy David Shawn Lynd was immediately suspended from the Sheriff's Office.

Officials said the arrest stems from an incident that happened on Tuesday and Wednesday within the Osage County Jail.

Lynd is being held at the Osage County Detention Center as OCSO investigates the case.

Undersheriff Gary Upton said, "The Osage County Sheriff's Office maintains a zero-tolerance policy towards corruption within our ranks or our county. We are steadfast in upholding the highest standards of integrity and accountability in all our operations."

Lynd is facing charges for:

- Endeavors or conspires to deliver, manufacture, or possess controlled dangerous substances
- Executive officer asking for/receiving bribe
- Carry weapon, drugs, or alcohol into jail
- Neglect of duty of deputy by Sheriff of jailer
