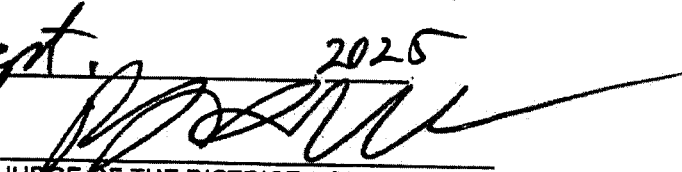

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Rules and Conditions of Supervised Probation through the District Attorney's Office

DEFENDANT'S INITIALS

- ME 1. I will agree in person or as directed by the District Attorney's office.
- ME 2. I agree to submit a written monthly probation report to the district attorney's office at IDABEL, Oklahoma on or before the first day of every month during the term of my probation with the first report to be submitted on or before the ____ day of _____, 20____.
- ME 3. I will not leave the state of Oklahoma without written permission of the judge or the district attorney's office, probation officer, nor will I change my address without notifying the District Attorney's office. I will allow an agent for the District Attorney to visit me at my home or elsewhere.
- ME 4. I will maintain lawful, gainful employment and provide written employment verification to the District Attorney as requested, I will support myself and all my dependents without public assistance so long as I am physically able to do so. I will notify my officer when I change employment and allow my officer to visit me at my employment or elsewhere.
- ME 5. I will not possess, consume, or purchase alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs, visit places where alcohol or illegal drugs are unlawfully sold, dispensed, or used. I further understand that I am not to enter bars, liquor stores, taverns, clubs, parties, or places where alcohol is the main item for sale or consumption.
- ME 6. I will not communicate with people who have a criminal record. I understand that it is my responsibility to know whether an associate has a criminal record. I will advise the district attorney of any family member who is a convicted felon.
- ME 7. I will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries from the District Attorney's office or its agents or other law enforcement personnel. I will carry out all lawful instructions they may give.
- ____ 8. I will not carry a concealable weapon of any type nor have in my possession or immediate control any firearm. I will not ride in a vehicle that has a firearm in it.
- ME 9. I understand that I am to remain under supervision by the District Attorney's office until I serve my maximum term unless I am placed on unsupervised status.
- ME 10. I will refrain from violation of City, State or Federal laws including Tribal Jurisdiction. I will advise the District Attorney within 48 hours if I am questioned or arrested by a branch of the government or a representative.
- ME 11. I understand that I am subject to search by an agent for the District Attorney. In addition, my vehicle and property under my control are subject to search. These searches will only occur upon reasonable suspicion of illegal activity being present.
- ME 12. I agree to pay a monthly probation fee of \$40.00 (money orders only) to the District Attorney's office in IDABEL, Oklahoma on or before the ____ day of each month during my probation term, with the first payment to be made on or before the ____ day of _____, 20____.
- ME 13. I understand that certain violations may result in the imposition of additional sanctions or revocation or acceleration of my sentence.

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14. I agree to submit to a random urinalysis at the discretion of the probation/supervision officer.
