NATION'S OBJECTION TO DEFENDANT'S WITNESS LIST

The Cherokee Nation, having just received a copy of the filed Defendant's Witness and Exhibit List on April 30, 2024, would state the following based on the list provided and conversations with Defense Counsel, Kendra Blocker:

1. The Nation objects to each witness listed by the Defense who intends to testify as to counseling or therapy sessions of the Defendant, and the character of the Defendant, as irrelevant;
2. The Nation objects to testimony of any witness listed by the Defense who do not have personal knowledge of any of the incidents alleged in the information;
3. The Nation reserves the right to file a Motion in Limine as to any statement made by any witness listed by the Defendant once the Defendant properly discloses the nature of their testimony;
4. The Nation is unable to list the specific witnesses as the list filed by the Defendant does not identify who individuals listed are nor state with any sort of specificity the nature of their testimony, only that each of the listed witnesses have "knowledge of the Defendant and issues pertaining to the allegations."
