The attached invoices are what they sent Feb. 10. These are not the invoices from 2022.

I worked 25 hours a week for PVLA, they can verify that in the emails to the accountant. 50 hours every pay period. CCC would range from 15-35 hours a week depending on what is going on. I clocked in on the time clock for CCC. Ask anyone- they will tell you how much time I spent there. I was there in the evenings doing student testing, or even in Schuyler (where CCC has a classroom) I can provide you with a list of names (employees) that could vouch how much time I spent there.

The \$14,485.16 amount- does that include all the invoices that I sent over? That number will go down significantly if I had 2022 invoices and the folders I asked for. Right now I have more invoices for 2022 than checks. Some of them I have not been reimbursed for. How come PVLA sent over some invoices for one check in 2022, but not the rest?

Sylvia did drop some stuff off at my house. There were NO files in that box. I did not walk out of the office with any folders. I left Wednesday June 29 with nothing- I gave Karen the keys.

I came back Thursday the 30th and Karen was in my office and she saw what I packed up.

All invoices/folders that were discussed during the interview with Strecker were given to him, or Karen/Sylvia. I showed them exactly where the folders and files were located.

There are a LOT of invoices missing. New Readers Press- I logged in with my CCC email to get a discount. I used my CCC email a lot for PVLA stuff to get a discount. I lot of checks were for books, and those are the files I need.

Regarding the laptop that the county attorney looked at- 4imprint- when I just logged on using PVLA credentials-There were 2 purchases from 2020 that are not listed above. I don't even see the one from 2020 they have listed.

There are invoice(s) for Better World Books- PVLA sent that over.

Fingerhut- That was a personal purchase from 2017

New Readers Press- I found one for 2022 for the grant, which PVLA provided. I used my CCC email on this site to obtain a discount since CCC is a member.

Oriental Trading only lets me go back to 2019 but it says no history. I have found invoices with the paperwork from OTC with 2019 date

There are invoices for Zoom I can send those over.

Not sure why some of these didn't show up. What about all the Amazon orders?

My ebay history only lets me go back to 2021

I am missing Hy-vee receipts, invoices for supplies for Columbus Days (several years), receipts from Walmart for supplies for the Behlen English classes, invoices for Columbus Custom Embroidery for pullovers, receipts for t-shirts I ordered for the parade. From Specialty Tee, receipts for Menards, receipts from Walmart for supplies for the classrooms like notebooks, pens, pencils, markers, erasers- bought every Jul/Aug when the school supplies came out. All of these would have been in with the invoices. Ask anyone from the office, and they will tell you this stuff was purchased.

Cannot get into Aztec Software or Pearson.com (both major book suppliers). These invoices would be in the book order folders.

Most of these charges should be dropped or down to misdemeanors, I cannot prove my innocence if I do not have all the evidence I need to prove these checks. These invoices DO EXIST! Ask anyone in the office, teachers, staff, students, volunteers- they will tell you about all the books and materials I provided.

So what is next? What happens if those invoices and files cannot be found? I am ready to discuss.
