On August 18, 2022, at approximately 23:36, Christine Knapp of 2564 Perkins Road, Danville, IA., 52623, called the Henry County Sheriff's Office and reported that a truck and title belonging to her was stolen by her husband John Knapp. Christine stated John informed her that he scrapped the truck. Christine wanted to report the truck as being stolen.

It should be noted Christine informed Dispatch she did not want law enforcement to respond to her residence due to the fact that she always ends up being arrested when law enforcement responds. Christine only wanted to be reached via phone.

I called Christine a short time later. It should be noted I did activate my body camera to record the course of the conversation.

Christine informed me that her 1998 Ford Ranger had been missing for two weeks. She stated she didn't see it removed, and it was usually parked in the yard. Christine stated on that night she was out in her other vehicle cleaning it out and found that the title to the ranger was missing. Christine stated she spoke to her husband, John Knapp, and he again informed her that he had scrapped the truck.

Christine then brought up that John wants her to go to jail because of damage that she just caused to his truck. She stated when she got home, she observed that her truck was missing. This caused her to become mad so she threw rocks at his truck. Christine stated it would be criminal mischief in the third degree, that she doesn't have to go to jail for it, and that she would pay the ticket.

Christine then stated she felt like she doesn't have to have any further conversation with us, meaning the sheriff's office, other than stating her truck, title, and registration is not there at her residence.

I asked Christine where John was at the moment. She stated she did not know.

Christine also stated that John took the keys to her truck a long time ago and wouldn't let her have them back. That was why it was parked in the yard.

Christine also stated John was supposed to swap the truck for a four-wheel drive truck for her. She stated that John said because she never gave him the title to do so, he scrapped the truck instead.

Christine then stated everything was missing, but everything had been at the residence at noon on that day. I clarified with her that she was speaking of the title, and she informed me, yes, on speaking about the title missing.

After speaking with Christine, I attempted to call John, but he did not answer his phone and I was unable to leave a voicemail.

The truck Christine was reporting stolen was an orange, 1998, Ford Ranger with VIN 1FTYR10C2WPA08786. The truck was registered to Christine.

I next drove down to Christine and John's residence.

John was out in his garage tinkering around on a truck.

I informed John I was there in regard to Christine's truck, the orange Ford Ranger.

John informed me the truck had been parked out back in his yard for approximately one year broke down the entire time. John stated that he sold the truck for scrap.

Before continuing to speak with John, he pointed out to me that Christine was sitting on top of the roof of the residence listening to us. I looked over onto the rood and saw that Christine was in fact on the roof. I had John walk further away from the residence to his back yard so I could speak with him privately.

John informed me that he was the one that bought the truck for Christine for \$3,000.

He said Christine did not like the truck and wouldn't accept it. He informed her at some point he would sell it for scrap then if she didn't want it. He said he was going to sell it for scrap because she was just going to give the truck away.

He said Christine got upset with him about selling the truck for scrap so she decided to damage another truck he owned.

John walked me over to a blue truck parked in front of his garage and showed me the damage. I observed the windshield was busted out, the passenger window had been completely broken out, and there was damage all around the truck from having rocks thrown at it.

John stated Christine had done all the damage to his truck within the previous week, and she told him he would continue to damage more of his property.

I asked John where or to whom he had sold the truck. John informed me he sold it to a guy in Burlington, Iowa, by the name of Chad. He said Chad was scrapping the truck for him.

I informed John that Christine was stating the title was missing. John stated that Christine informed him the night prior that she was leaving him and started to pack a bunch of her property in her car. John stated that she had missed placed the title and that he had never touched it.

I next followed John into his garage so he could grab his phone to look up the contact information to the guy he sold the truck to. While he was looking for the contact information, Christine came down to the garage to listen to the conversation I was having with John.

Christine stated John was probably telling me stories of how she assaulted him, and John took the title.

I informed Christine that John wasn't making stories up about her.

John did not have the contact information to the guy he sold the truck to and stated he would get me the contact information the next day.

I left the residence without incident.

It should be noted I, at the time of speaking with Christine and John, did not know if the matter over the truck was a civil issue or not. I spoke with Chief Deputy Chad Doak pertaining to this case. He advised it sounded like a civil issue. He also informed me the truck could be sold without the title due to the vehicle being 20 years old or more.

I was unable to follow up with John or Christine the next day on my shift due to dealing with other calls on that night, one being a domestic.

On August 20, 2022, at approximately 2:27PM, Christine emailed the entire sheriff's office alleging I did not take a statement from her regarding the truck she had reported stolen and only spoke to John. She also stated she only wanted an officer to handle the case who was certified in scrap vehicle regulations. She also stated she located a truck at a car dealership, R & S Auto, in Middletown, Iowa, that was possibly the truck. Christine also emailed me a picture of the title to the truck. It showed the truck was titled in her name. Please refer to the picture of the title provided.

At 7:45PM on August 20, 2022, I called County Attorney Darin Stater to ask his opinion on this case. Darin informed me it was all a civil issue due to the fact they are married and that we would not have anything to do with anything involving their property.

On August 20, 2022, when I started my shift at 11:00PM, I drove over to Middletown to the car dealership Christine emailed about. The car dealership is actually called R & A Auto.

I did locate a orange Ford Ranger sitting on the lot, but found the VIN did not match the VIN number of Christine's truck.

I next met with Park Ranger Drew Kuckler in Geode State Park and requested for him to assist me in informing Christine this was all a civil issue.

At approximately 11:35PM, we arrived at Christine's residence.

We first spoke to John out in his garage. I informed him it was all a civil issue.

I next walked over to the residence and knocked on the door to speak to Christine. She would not answer the door. John had to go into the residence and get her for me so I could speak with her.

Christine was not happy with me being there at that time of night. She said, "Well it's midnight, its kind of rude, I'm sleeping."

Christine asked if we could talk in the morning. I informed her no; I work nights

and was there to speak with her right at that moment.

I informed Christine that it was a civil issue between she and John.

Christine stated I could have sent her an email over this. I informed her I decided to do it in person since she stated I did not take her statement the other night. She said I know you didn't. I informed her I spoke with her over the phone.

Christine walked back into the house.

Park Ranger Kuckler and I left the residence without incident.

At this time, I have nothing further to add to this case. This report is for informational purposes only.
