DETAILS:

On 03/17/2022, I was contacted by KARI SANDOVAL from Sierra Recycling regarding JONATHAN FIKE contacting the business and harassing employees.

SANDOVAL sent me the following email:

"From: Jonathan <jonthn4411@gmail.com>

Date: March 16, 2022 at 2:50:20 PM PDT

Subject: Re: Sierra recycling

Can I pick up the money you guys owe me yet? FYI the law specifically states that a hold can be placed on any materials that have been "PURCHASED" by the business. You guys have not "PURCHASED" the materials from me yet. You guys have stolen the materials from me by not paying after the 3 days. which the law states payment shall be made after the 3rd business day after receiving the materials. I want my money NOW.

On Sun, Mar 13, 2022 at 12:05 PM Jonathan <jonthn4411@gmail.com> wrote:

Hey Jose, I recently sold you guys some metal but after waiting 3+days, when I returned, I was told I would not be receiving the payment. They gave me the phone number of a detective giannelli and told to contact him to release the "hold" on the payment. I contacted giannelli and explained my situation to him. The rat bastard told me he didn't believe me, and that he will not release the "sheriff's hold" on my account. I asked him which law gives him the authority to withhold payment from me. Section 6 21606-21609 of the business and professions code is the law you guys are operating under. But both of you guys are applying it incorrectly, and are unlawfully withholding payment from myself, and I'm sure many others. See 21606 (a) says a sheriff can place a hold "on materials that have been purchased and are in possession of a junk dealer / recycler" and only if that officer has probable cause to believe that the materials are linked to a specific crime and are needed as evidence to prosecute criminals. Note: The law does not give them authority to withhold or instruct a business to withhold payment from anyone. but instead states payment shall be provided after the 3rd business day, and a hold may be placed on the 'MATERIALS' included in the reported "PURCHASES" of the business. You will also find, no part of the statute says anything about paying an individual whos materials were subject to a hold following the release by the department who placed the hold on the materials. This is because in order for an officer to order the business to "hold" and not destroy specified materials in case they are needed in an investigation, for a period not to exceed 60 days, The business must first have purchased and possess the materials. So we have a problem. I have a receipt that states I was to be paid for materials I sold to you but you guys are trying to rob me. Will you instruct your co-workers to pay me

DETAILS:

On 03/16/2022, at approximately 1512 hours, I received an email from "temp email <emailtemp851@gmail.com>" believed to be JONATHAN FIKE that states the following:

"Every junk dealer or recycler shall, during normal business hours, allow periodic inspection of any premises maintained and any junk thereon for the purpose of determining compliance with the recordkeeping requirements of this article, and shall during those hours produce his or her records of sales and purchases, except as provided in subparagraph (B) of paragraph (6) of subdivision (a) of Section 21608.5, and all property purchased incident to those transactions which is in the possession of the junk dealer or recycler for inspection by any of the following persons:

- (a) An officer holding a warrant authorizing him or her to search for personal property.
- (b) A person appointed by the sheriff of a county or appointed by the head of the police department of a city.
- (c) An officer holding a court order directing him or her to examine the records or property.
- (d) The amendments to this section made by the act 1 adding this subdivision shall become operative on December 1,...

Read the law giannelli. It does not give you the authority to steal from individuals. You only have authority in regards to materials held by a junk dealer which is in possession of property it has purchased. The property is mine, not the businesses because they never purchased it from me. So do me a favor and make a report. I'd like to report a theft of copper by sierra recycling and demolition. They took my property and promised to pay after 3 days. I have a receipt to prove it, But after the 3rd day they refused to pay me. They have committed larceny.

You do not have the authority to seize my property, you can only seize/place a hold on property that has been purchased by the junk dealer (meaning the junk dealers property, hence once the materials are not needed for prosecution of criminal, they are released back to the junk dealer, not the individual they seized it from.) until the junk dealer purchases my property, it remains my property. And if you think its necessary in some investigation you have going on then you need to tell them to purchase it from me so you can order them not to dispose of it. Because right now it is MY PROPERTY, AND I DEMAND PAYMENT OR MY PROPERTY BACK NOW. which is it going to be, PAYMENT or PROPERTY? If I dont receive payment or property by friday, I will be calling I.A. and leaving a message for Donny Youngblood, as well as the attorney general about your guys scam your running, defrauding and depriving private individuals of their property under color of law."

NARRATIVE

DETAILS:

On 03/08/2022, I was reviewing recycling receipts from Sierra Recycling at 1620 E. Brundage Lane.

I noticed on ticket number 1950494 that JONATHAN FIKE brought in 102 pounds of #1 bright and shiny copper wire on 03/04/2022 at approximately 1241 hours. FIKE did not have a business attached to his name and recycled a large amount of copper wire.

I contacted KARI SANDOVAL from Sierra Recycling and asked her to provide the recycling receipt for ticket number 1950494. SANDOVAL provided me with photographs of the copper wire material FIKE brought to recycle. I noticed in the photographs, the copper wire appeared to be large gauge and a large quantity. The copper wire had been stripped from the insulation and was bare.

I recognized the type of wire FIKE was in possession of was used to run large amounts of electricity and is usually owned or used for water or utility purposes. I know subjects steal copper wire such as the material FIKE brought into the business for money. There have been numerous copper wire thefts throughout Kern County from utilities, oil field pumping units, and agriculture water wells. I placed a 90 day hold on the material per B&P 21609 and advised SANDOVAL to have FIKE contact me if he comes to the business to get paid for the material.

On 03/08/2022 at approximately 1520 hours, FIKE called me about the hold that was placed on the copper wire material. I asked FIKE where he received the material. FIKE told me he was with a subject named "VITO" who assisted him with receiving the material. FIKE told me they took the copper wire from an agriculture water well on an unknown farm in the area between the city of Shafter and the city of Wasco. I asked FIKE who gave him permission to take the material. FIKE said the "farmer." I asked FIKE what the farmer's name was, he told me while stammering "Pancho." I asked FIKE if he knew his real name or any paperwork showing where he received the material, he told me he did not. I asked FIKE if he knew where exactly the farm is, he told me he did not.

I asked FIKE what VITO's real name was, he told me he did not know. FIKE told me he met VITO through a friend named JUAN [REDACTED]. I asked FIKE why he thought it was not a problem to take the copper wire, he told me "it was scrap." I told FIKE there is no situation I could see where a farmer would give him permission to take copper wire from an agriculture water well.

In my training and experience, I have never heard of any situation where a farmer has let someone remove copper wire from an agriculture water well which would ultimately cost the farmer \$5,000 to \$20,000 to repair the unit. I asked FIKE if he could provide me with an email explaining where the material was taken from and the information he had provided me. I ended my conversation with FIKE.

At 1533 hours, FIKE called me back angry that I would not let Sierra Recycling pay him for the material. I explained to FIKE that based on his story, he and VITO had essentially stolen copper wire from an agriculture water well. Based on FIKE explaining the circumstance on how he obtained the material, I believed he was in violation of PC 496A(A)- Receiving material used for utility. FIKE told me to provide him with the material he had recycled. I told FIKE I would not be returning the material based on the information that was provided to me by him. FIKE continued to accuse me that I did not have the authority to prevent him from recycling the material. I told FIKE he told me he took the material from an agriculture water well and he does not have any documentation or plausible information showing he obtained the material by legal means.

I told FIKE to send me an email with his explanation of the acquired material. At approximately 1655 hours, I received an email from "temp email emailtemp851@gmail.com" that said the following:

"Hi, this is the email correspondence you requested regarding my recent recycling activities. The materials I recently recycled I can assure you with absolute certainty, were not related to any theft or crime. They were mine, and I recycled them. I do not wish to engage in conversation related to my personal or business life with you, or anyone else for that matter. I looked up the law you cited over the phone to me, that allegedly prohibited anyone who is not an electrician from possessing copper cable, and you are mistaken sir. The law does not prohibit any private citizen from possessing or recycling copper materials. I believe any issues related to recycling and the law would be with the recycling company, not the private citizen customers that recycle there.

Please instruct sierra recycling to release payment to me, since the 3 day hold on the payment has expired and payment is due. I appreciate your cooperation in this matter. Please do not harass, ask me to jump through hoops, or threaten to withhold money that is mine. If sierra recycling does not want me using their facility, then once I receive payment [money I have the receipt showing they are holding] I will not return.
Thanks."

This email is believed to be from FIKE, he does not discuss how he obtained the material or contacts to reference, or contact who is believed to be the legal owner of the property.

Based on the above information, I am requesting charges of PC 496A(A)- Receiving materials used for utility. I provided Sierra Recycling with a documented copy, 90 day hold on the material per B&P 21609. I will not be releasing the material for FIKE to possess and the material will be kept at Sierra Recycling property.

I attached the documents regarding the 90 day hold, email from FIKE, and the recycling receipts.
